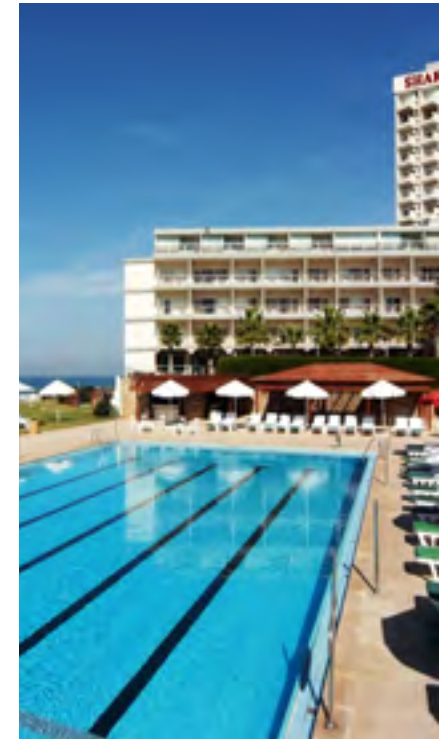


Strolling Herzliya's sandy beaches becomes a learning experience, with guideposts explaining natural phenomena, vegetation, the historic sites along the way and much more. A seven-kilometer walking path stretches from the Herzliya-Tel Aviv border until the Tel Michal cliff. A shorter, two-kilometer path starts at Appolonia (Sidna Ali).



An international port with 700 moorings, Herzliya's marina is the biggest, most modern and exclusive in the Mediterranean Basin. During the year, it hosts international naval reviews and sailing competitions, as well as local water sports clubs. The marina also has a pedestrian plaza, recreational areas, entertainment and commercial centers.

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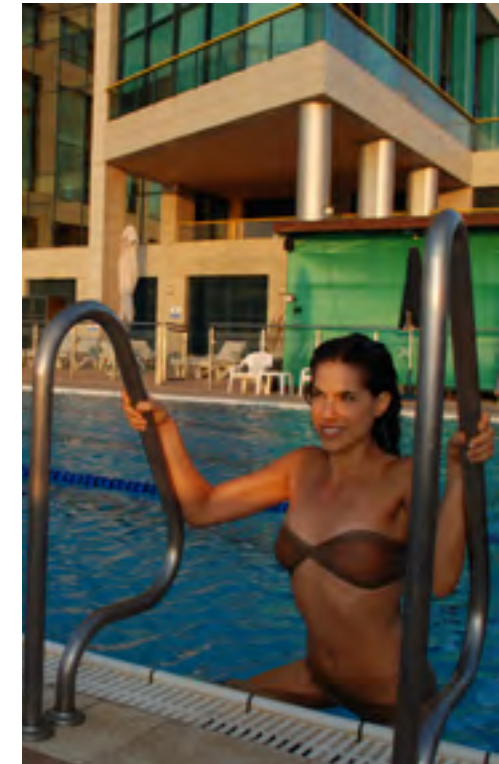

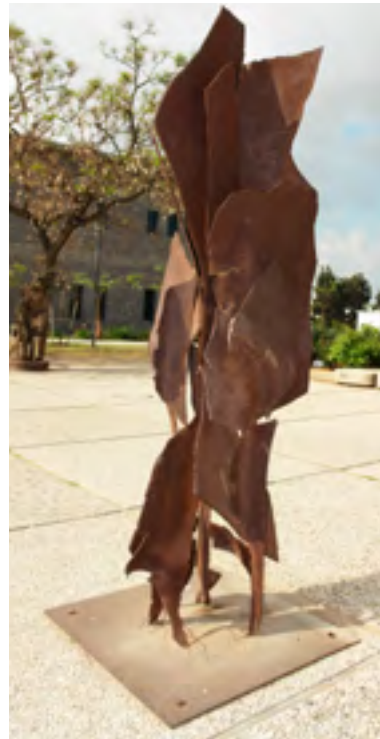

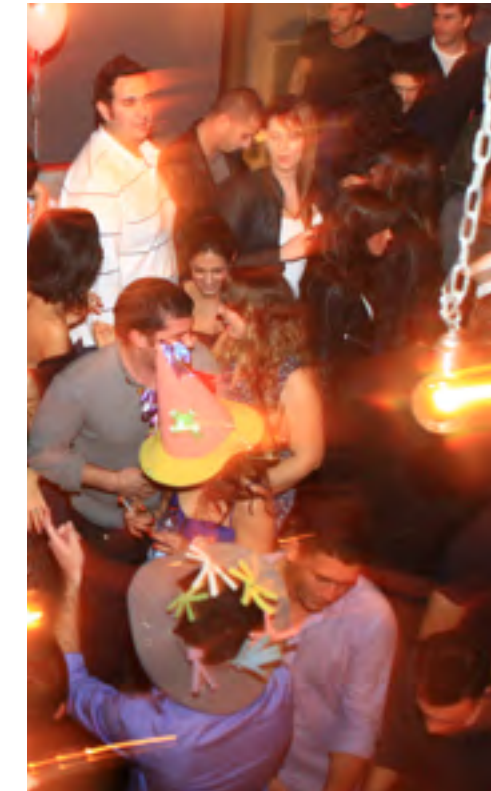

Herzliya offers its guests a variety of both prestigious and affordable restaurants. **Port** restaurant, at the far end of the marina, serves Mediterranean food in view of the docked yachts. The all-kosher **Meat and Wine** restaurant has a long tradition of steaks and more, hand grilled by an artist. And at the venerable **Kyoto** restaurant, you'll find a traditional Japanese kitchen.



Nightlife in Herzliya includes cafes, bars and clubs. At nightfall, Herzliya's hi-tech industrial zone becomes a lively hot spot. But to relax, **Café Bono** is the place.
